The rooms at the bottom oval are now completed and are superb. Without doubt the facilities and surrounds of the Montmorency ovals make it one if the premier venues in the area. On top of the refurbishment at the bottom oval the top oval is about to get extensive new room renovations of approximately \$100,000.

The new lights for the bottom oval are nearly completed. These lights will be of the highest standard outside of AFL level in the state with Lux capacity far in excess of anything ever seen before at suburban level. The towers have being extended by 6 meters and 20 new individual lights have being fitted.

Make sure you get along to the big match against Heidelberg under lights on Anzac Day!

Both ovals playing surfaces are in very good condition. The bottom oval in particular has come a long way over summer and looks in great shape. We should be in for a great season!
